Random Stuff...

Late night building here in Norway. I wanted too share some clamps that I made to hold things in place while gluing. I used wooden clothespeggs/clothespin(US). I take one apart and glue the 2 wooden parts to the other. It makes them grab a little wider and not so much pressure on the model. I just used normal whiteglue.
